SUBMISSION

➤ Abstract submission

An extended abstract must be submitted and is subject to peer review. Abstracts should comprise up to 500 words and include:

- ❖ Title
- ❖ Author names, affiliations and email addresses
- ❖ Research context and background
- ❖ Research question/problem statement
- ❖ Methods/approaches
- ❖ Results (Found/initial/expected)
- ❖ Discussion/contribution/potential contribution
- ❖ Keywords

➤ Full paper submission

Full papers should be submitted before the conference with at least 3000 words, including abstract, references, figures, and tables. Full papers will optionally be reviewed and published in the conference e-proceeding with an ISBN.

➤ Language: English

➤ Format: full papers need to be formatted as follows

Font: Arial. Size 12. Line space: 1.5 lines.

Heading style: using heading numbering as the following example

1. INTRODUCTION (BOLD, UPPER CASE)

1.1. Research background (Bold, Sentence case)

1.1.1. Post COVID-19 challenges (Italic)
